KEY FEATURES OF THE SUB-FUND

WHAT ARE YOU INVESTING IN?

- You are investing in a ILP Sub-Fund that feeds 100% into an Underlying Fund, a sub-fund of BlackRock Global Funds (“BGF”).
- BGF is an open-ended investment company incorporated in Luxembourg and its home regulator is the Commission de Surveillance du Secteur Financier (CSSF).

Investment Strategy	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Underlying Fund invests at least 70% of its total assets in high yield fixed income transferable securities denominated in US dollars. The Underlying Fund may invest in the full spectrum of available fixed income transferable securities, including non-investment grade. Currency exposure is flexibly managed. As part of its investment objective the Underlying Fund may invest up to 20% of its total assets in ABS and MBS whether investment grade or not. These may include asset-backed commercial paper, collateralised debt obligations, collateralised mortgage obligations, commercial mortgage-backed securities, creditlinked notes, real estate mortgage investment conduits, residential mortgage-backed securities and synthetic collateralised debt obligations. The underlying assets of the ABS and MBS may include loans, leases or receivables (such as credit card debt, automobile loans and student loans in the case of ABS and commercial and residential mortgages originating from a regulated and authorised financial institution in the case of MBS). The ABS and MBS in which the Underlying Fund invests may use leverage to increase return to investors. Certain ABS may be structured by using a derivative such as a credit default swap or a basket of such derivatives to gain exposure to the performance of securities of various issuers without having to invest in the securities directly. The Underlying Fund's exposure to Distressed Securities is limited to 10% of its total assets and its exposure to contingent convertible bonds is limited to 20% of total assets. 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VALUATIONS AND EXITING FROM THIS INVESTMENT

<p>HOW OFTEN ARE VALUATIONS AVAILABLE?</p> <p>All ILP Sub-Funds will be priced based on the frequency of the fund manager’s pricing. The fund prices are updated daily and are available at Singapore Life Ltd.’s website at www.singlife.com.</p> <p>HOW CAN YOU EXIT FROM THIS INVESTMENT AND WHAT ARE THE RISKS AND COSTS IN DOING SO?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> You can exit the ILP Sub-Fund by submitting a request for withdrawal or fund switching (i.e. switches) to Singapore Life Ltd. If your Policy is newly incepted, you may cancel the Policy by giving us written notice of cancellation provided that such notice of cancellation is received by Singapore Life Ltd. at its Registered Office within the free-look period, which is fourteen (14) days from the date on which you receive the Policy. Upon cancellation of the Policy, Singapore Life Ltd. will refund the premiums you paid (without interest) after deducting the expenses incurred in issuing the Policy. The refund will be made after we receive the original Policy for cancellation. If there has been a decline in the market value, we will deduct the amount necessary to reflect the change in market value. If there has been an increase in the market value following the date Singapore Life Ltd. accepts your request to cancel the Policy, we will not pay you for such increase or any gain. For subsequent withdrawal/surrender or fund switching, transaction requests will need to be received and accepted by Singapore Life Ltd.: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) before 12 noon (Singapore time) on a Business Day will be processed according to the Unit Prices of the relevant Funds and the exchange rates (if applicable) prevailing on the next appropriate Fund Valuation Date following the day Singapore Life Ltd. has accepted the request. (b) after 12 noon (Singapore time) on a Business Day or on a non-business day will be considered as if received before 12 noon (Singapore time) on the following business day. The ILP Sub-Fund will have a single “dealing” price used for all switches and withdrawals/surrenders. There is no bid/offer spread. All ILP Sub-Funds will be priced based on the frequency of the fund manager’s pricing policy. As Units are cancelled using a forward price, the unit price for all switching and withdrawal of units will not be available at the time of receiving your application. This cut-off time stated is correct as at the time of print. Singapore Life Ltd. reserves the right to change the cut-off time by giving you thirty (30) days’ prior notice or any such shorter period of notice as Singapore Life Ltd. may agree with the relevant authorities.
